Follow these instructions when making a Flipgrid defense video;

- 1. Make a list of the KEY TERMS and CONCEPTS relating to your chosen topic. This will serve as a Word Bank for you to use to ensure nothing is forgotten or emitted from your video.
- 2. Create a script for your Flipgrid video that clearly demonstrates your understanding of the chosen topic, correctly using the key vocabulary terms and concepts listed in your word bank. Use completed notes and assignments from class and previous lessons as information resources when writing your script to ensure accuracy.
- 3. Make your Flipgrid video. You can practice reading your script as many times as you like before recording, but when you do record your video, follow these presentation guidelines;
 - do not be looking at or reading any notes or scripts.
 - look at the camera the entire time while speaking
 - speak clearly and loud enough to be heard.
 - record a video that is 30-90 seconds in length.
